FINAL INSTRUCTION NO. 1

Rounds 9 & 10 of the 2022 ALEKTO Hillclimb and Sprint
Championship

1. Amendment to Event Regulations:

The maximum number of starters each day for the 2022 Danny Gormley Memorial Knockalla Hillclimb will be 100.

The organising committee would like to thank the Hillclimb and Sprint Commission and MotorSport Ireland for their agreement with this amendment and also for their help and support with this event to date.

COMPETITORS PLEASE NOTE:

A trailer park has been organised for this event and this must be used by all competitors. We have a large entry so please respect other competitors and also please respect the emergency access route through the paddock. This will be strictly enforced. We thank you in advance for your co-operation with this matter.

2. Please enter the hill from the Paddock side and follow the instructions of the Marshals. Trailers are to be left in the field allocated at the start of the Paddock Area. Trailers are left there at the owner's risk.
3. The field where trailer park is located in is also now part of the paddock for this event. All competitors in rally cars will be using this field as their paddock area.
4. **ADDITION SCRUTINY:** Scrutiny will be available on Friday evening 2nd September at the bottom of the hill from 17.30 hrs until 20.30 hrs. We would encourage as many competitors as possible to use this additional scrutiny as we need to run this event to a strict time schedule due to the large entry. Your help with this matter would be greatly appreciated.
5. Scrutiny on Saturday and Sunday morning will be from 07.00 am until 09.00 am.
6. After scrutiny, please make your way to the administration suite which will be located at the start line. Any competitor NOT signed on by 10am on Saturday or Sunday will be deemed to be a non-starter.
7. Drivers Briefing will be held at the start line at **9.30am SHARP** each day. **All competitors must attend.**
8. Practise Run will commence at 10.30 am each day.
9. First Timed Run will commence at 11.45 am each day.

10. A beam strut MUST be fitted to all cars. (As per current MI YearBook)
11. Please have your competition licence ready for inspection when signing on.
12. Competitors MUST check that they are entered for the correct class before they start this event. (Please check this both days!)
13. Competitors are reminded that all Rally Cars must run 'Rally Ready'. (As per current MI Yearbook)
14. For DUAL entries, on each run, the first driver will descend the hill last, while the second driver will wait at the start line to take over and will immediately go up the hill again. (Time is important on the day, so please be ready.)
15. Competitors MUST ensure that they walk the hill and familiarise themselves with the course. There is a restriction on the use of motorised vehicles on the course at the weekend.
16. Tyre warming is strictly NOT permitted.
17. Saturday Prizegiving will take place in Ripple's Restaurant, Kerrykeel, Co. Donegal, F92 VX00 @ 8.30 pm. A dinner will be provided, and tickets will be available at the admin suite. We would encourage all to attend. Sunday Prizegiving will take place in the paddock at the bottom of the hill as soon as the results are final.
18. Motorsport Ireland permit No: 22/093 has been issued for this event.
19. Please take all your litter home.
